IT IS NOT A REQUIREMENT TO HAVE SPEED LIMIT STICKER FOR FIRE ENGINE VEHICLE INSPECTION

We refer to the article published on China Press today titled "Speed Limit Sticker Required For PUSPAKOM Inspection".

PUSPAKOM Sdn Bhd (PUSPAKOM) would like to clarify that it is not a requirement to have a speed limit sticker on the body of fire engine vehicle during its inspection. Under The Road Transport Act 1987, commercial vehicles including fire engine vehicle are required to undergo Routine Inspection at PUSPAKOM every 6 months to ensure it is roadworthy.
